BSR Members are invited to participate in a variety of collaborative initiatives ranging from learning communities to collective action to advance the Sustainable Development Goals. This document lists the BSR collaborative initiatives and partnerships that are available for companies to participate in during 2025.

BSR's Collaborations are organized by issue area—business transformation; climate change; equity, inclusion, and justice; human rights; and nature. This document includes a brief description of each initiative, pricing information and a list of which departments beyond the sustainability team would benefit from participation. It also highlights for BSR members with annual dues of US\$15,000 or more how they can apply their BSR Member Engagement Option to offset the annual fee for some initiatives.

The majority of BSR collaborative initiatives run on a January-December schedule; however, most groups are open to members joining throughout the calendar year.
